115 COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT

CC Jackie Brockway stated that she would be visiting areas of her Ward during Tuesday 7th April with a Highways Officer and if there were any issues she would be pleased to take them up with the Officer.

CC Brockway explained that the electoral boundaries would be changed in 2017 but until that time she would remain County Councillor for Greetwell.

116 DISTRICT COUNCILLORS REPORT

DC Malcolm Leaning explained that there would be no increase in the District Council's element of the Council tax.

DC Giles McNeill stated that the District Council were investing funds in upgrading properties in the District.

Green bins would remain at no charge to residents during the forthcoming year.

117 CORRESPONDENCE AND REPORTS

A) Highway Matters

Community Speedwatch – It was considered that there were sufficient 30mph signs on Westfield Drive but that eight 40mph signs should be sited on Wragby Road East. Cllr John Taylor kindly offered to site them. Expenditure for the cost of £56 was proposed by Councillor John Taylor, seconded by Councillor Mrs Sarah Bates.

- B) Open Gardens Event Eleven requests/invitations for sponsorship for the event had been sent to local business persons. One had responded with a cheque for £50. There had been one refusal.
- C) Elections 2015 Report of attendance at training seminar by Councillor Mrs Sarah Bates – Mrs Bates stated that she felt that this seminar had been more suited to larger Councils.

The Clerk had now received nomination forms for the election and these were distributed to current Councillors. Further publicising of the forthcoming election would continue.

D) Neighbourhood Plan – Councillors Mrs Sarah Bates and Mrs Rosemary Seal had attended a Neighbourhood Planning Seminar on 11th February 2015.

Councillor Mrs Sarah Bates proposed, Councillor Chris Thatcher seconded, that a survey be drawn up for Greetwell residents and circulated with the Greetwell News at some time in the near future with a small cash prize draw as an incentive for the return of surveys. This would obtain views from residents to establish whether there was support for drawing up a Neighbourhood Plan. A vote was taken which was unanimous.

Councillor Mrs Sarah Bates agreed to contact Community Lincs for assistance with the survey questions.
