LET'S KEEP GREETWELL TIDY



We would like to provide you with an update on our Elsham to Lincoln pipeline project.

Work is progressing well with pipe installation underway. We are also focusing on reinstating land and where possible, returning it to landowners.

To allow us to continue our work safely at crossing points and key locations, we will still need to close certain roads during this time. Any closures will be communicated to local parishes, residents and businesses at least 14 days in advanced.

On the northern section between Elsham and Lincoln, good progress is being made, with 21km of pipe already in the ground. Reinstatement and land drainage are also being carried out at various locations.

We expect pipelaying to be finished by Summer 2027, with reinstatement works to be completed by late 2027. Pipe swabbing (washing) and commissioning of the pipeline will also take place around the same time.

The replanting of trees and hedgerows is ongoing. The site team expecting this work to be completed across the project by late 2027. These works will also be supported by a five-year period of aftercare.

We have already completed a complex crossing under the railway line at Kettleby, which was carried out using a tunnel boring machine (TBM). Several road crossings and horizontal directional drills also remain to be completed.

News from your Parish Council

Well, the year moves on and we are heading towards December and the Christmas lights switch on. Again we have been very fortunate in having our local garage, Ascona, support the event and provide the mince pies.

Seat on Westfield Avenue – The Parish Council has purchased a seat which will shortly be sited on Westfield Avenue roundabout (it may already be there by the time you receive this publication!) The seat was paid for from monies received via new developments in the parish (Community Infrastructure Levy).

Mr Grayham Lidgett, our local building contractor, kindly offered to accept delivery of the very heavy seat, made from recycled material, and install it on the roundabout at no cost to the Parish. Sincere thanks are extended to him.

The trees on the roundabout have also been trimmed back to make the area more attractive.

Flower tubs - A local resident has also kindly taken over the maintenance and planting of the flower tubs on the corner of Westfield Drive which are looking colourful again. Thanks are extended to Vicky for taking on this task.

Poppies - The Parish Council donated £50 to the Royal British Legion for ten large poppies for fixing to various posts on the A158. They have received favourable comments, and it is hoped to add to the numbers next year so that they may be displayed in the Westfield areas.

Speed Indicator Device – A158 – Residents may have noticed that this has been removed. This follows the post being hit and damaged. Fortunately, the device is intact and as soon as a new post is sited by the Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership the device will be re-sited.

Councillor Vacancy – A vacancy exists on the Parish Council – it is hoped to co-opt at the Parish Council meeting on 1st December. For further details please contact the Clerk on <u>Greetwellparishcouncil@gmail.com</u> Please consider joining a friendly team doing their best for the community.
